Dual Credit Information



All BHS students interested in dual enrollment may enroll in the amount of classes limited by CBC and/or DMC.

Students/Parents are responsible for payment of tuition, fees and books.

Scholarships and Grants may be available on a first come first serve basis. Student must complete required forms to be considered.

Reimbursement of tuition and fees is allowed for Core Area classes (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies) once the course is complete based on the grade that is earned. {A=100%, B=75%, C=50% reimbursement}


Reimbursement of books is allowed for Core Area classes.


For reimbursements to be processed a copy of the bill/receipt and grades (for tuition) must be submitted to Ms. Davis

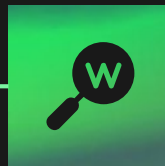

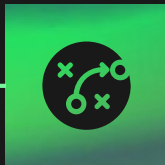
